ELIGIBILITY

The contest is open to all employees of ABU members and affiliates, including staff of the ABU Secretariat. No limit is placed on the number of entry submissions.

COMPETITION RULES

- > The design must be original and include the words "ABU" and "Asia-Pacific Broadcasting Union".
- > The design can be created on a computer or drawn by hand.
- > No more than four solid colours may be used, in addition to black and white. Gradients should not be used.
- > The design must reproduce plainly in black and white/grayscale and at various sizes
- > The design must be free of 'detail', but eye-catching and able to represent the Union clearly.
- > The design must be an original creation or an updated version of the existing logo.
- > It is required that each entry be accompanied by an electronic version
 - in PDF or EPS format (compatible with Adobe Illustrator 7.0)
 - on CD or floppy disk, and
 - printed in full colour on A4-size white paper
 - with a completed entry form (available from the ABU website)
- > Entries submitted will not be returned.
- By submitting the design, the contestant warrants that the design is the sole, exclusive and original work of the contestant or contestants, that neither the design nor any part thereof is a copy of any other work or infringes upon the copyright or any other rights of any person or corporation anywhere in the world, and that the design or any right or interest therein has not been previously sold, assigned, or in any other way disposed of.
- For and in consideration of the prize to be awarded, the winning contestant/s completely assigns, waives, and transfers to the ABU the entire right, ownership and interest, including the copyrights, trademarks and moral rights, in and to the winning logo design.
- The winning contestant/s shall indemnify, save and hold the ABU harmless from any loss or damage in connection with any breach by the said contestant/s of any warranty or agreement herein stated.
- > The ABU reserves the right to alter or modify the winning design if necessary.
- The winner (or one representative of the winners if the entry is a joint submission) will be invited to the ABU's General Assembly in Hyderabad, India, in 2005 (an economy class airfare and hotel accommodation will be provided), where they will be formally acknowledged and presented with a commemorative certificate and a cash prize of US\$1,000 for their winning entry.
- The winning entry will be announced on a date to be determined in late 2004 or early 2005 depending on the number of entries received and whether the ABU's Administrative Council deems it necessary for the general membership of the ABU to vote on a short-list of entries.
- Contest deadline is July 31, 2004.
