<u>ข้อเท็จจริง</u>

(The best Television Education programme for youth on public issue)

Initially, AIBD will present recognition Awards for television programmes in the following categories: -

- 1. The best Television documentary programme on rural development
- The best TV documentary programme promoting national unity and harmony
- 3. The best TV Education programme for youth on public issues

The prize for each of the above Awards will be a **cash prize of US\$1,000.00** along with a **trophy and certificate from the AIBD**. In selecting programs for entry, broadcasters are encouraged to pay attention to the respective criteria as detailed in the attachment, which will be referenced during the judging process. They will allow judges to compare programs of different presentation on an equal basis. An entry form (enclosed) with a copy <u>for each programme submitted</u> should reach the AIBD <u>not later than May 15, 2005</u>.

The programme, if not in English language, must have English subtitles.

The best Television documentary programme on rural development

This category includes documentaries (10-60 minutes) portraying national or local projects related to agricultural policy and measures to support employment in rural areas. It can cover issues such as: modernization of farms, fair and stable income for farmers, safety and quality of food products, environmental challenges, supplementary or alternative job-creating activities, in a bid to halt the drift from the countryside and to strengthen the economic and social fabric of rural areas, improvement of living and working conditions, and promotion of equal opportunities.

2. The best TV documentary programme promoting national unity and harmony

This category includes documentaries (10-60 minutes) promoting justice, equality, fairness and friendship and aiming at eliminating the barriers to mutual understanding between different groups/communities. The programme should take a stand against racism, prejudices and discrimination at a national level and offer the viewers the opportunity to appreciate the many faces, the many voices and the visions of their country.

3.

The best TV Education programme for youth on public issues

This category covers various areas such as: family, health, social –urban/rural- life, trend, art and entertainment. Entries should be aimed at 12-15 year old children.

NOTE: All TV programmes will be judged according to the following two criteria :-

Idea:

Is the concept relevant for the selected theme? How effective is the programme in dealing with this issue? Is it properly targeted? Does it communicate the underlying purpose of the program? Is it innovative, creative, and imaginative? Does it convey a relevant message to the viewers? Does it capture and hold their attention?

Production values: Are the sets, the camera work, the lighting, and the sound quality coordinated so as to enhance the presentation? Do the casting, costuming, writing, directing, editing, etc., convey the idea of this program effectively to the viewer?

Entry Submission:

An entry form (enclosed) and a copy <u>for each programme submitted</u> should reach the AIBD <u>not later than May 15, 2005</u>. The programme, if not in English language, must have English subtitles.

AIBD will present recognition for the following two awards :-

- 1. "The most well conceived and implemented digital radio archive"
 - -(This award consist of a cash prize of US\$ 1,000.00, along with a trophy and a certificate from the AIBD).
- 2. Reinhard Keune's Memorial Award on:
 - "The best Radio Programme on local minorities"
 - (This award consist of a cash prize of US\$ 1,000.00, along with a trophy and a certificate from the AIBD). This award will be supported by Radio Australia.
 - 1. The most well conceived and implemented digital radio archive

Criteria for Eligibility :

Eligible are all digital radio archive projects that are either fully functional/ implemented or which are partly implemented and are still in a project phase.

- Required documents for eligibility -: Detailed Project Description which contains:
- > Detailed list of all Hardware components (Server, network, audio work stations, audio cards, data carriers (media) for the archived material etc.)
- Technical details about the digital format(s) used
- > Backup strategies > Detailed description of Software used (screenshots)
- > Description of the changed workflow, Description of digital archiving strategy
- Description of archive content
- (types and amounts of archive documents in terms of number and time)
- Description of the catalogue or data base
- (type, structure, fields with 10 example entries)

A full set of photographs showing all important elements of the installation must accompany the report.

2 Reinhard Keune's Memorial Award on:

"The best Radio Programme on local minorities"

Criteria for eligibility:

Eligible are all radio documentaries/features which portray a local minority and educate in an unobtrusive way about the culture, history, language etc. of a given minority group.

The programmes will be judged using the following criteria :-

- Use of: Language, Voices, Pacing, Music, SF'x, Drama/suspense, Humor a.
- How creative/innovative is the final mix? b.
- C. Target group orientation
- d How well does the message come over (evocative/engaging)?
- How convincing/involving is the programme? e.
- Quality of the script -(Is the programme shedding new lights on the topic?) f.

In selecting applications for radio awards, broadcasters are encouraged to pay attention to the abovementioned criteria, which will be referenced during the judging process.

Each broadcasting organization may introduce up to three entries for any of the said awards. These programmes could be all produced by one producer, or they could be produced by different producers.

Entry Submission :

The entry form (enclosed) with a copy of the programme(s), along with a full English translation should reach the AIBD not later than 15th of May 2005.
