Important Notice for Applying to the Chiba Prefecture Overseas Technical Trainees Acceptance Program

1. The Trainees Program for the fiscal year 2005 will consist of a 3 months stay (approximate at this stage) from late September to late December. The time period is currently under consultation. Applicants will be informed of the exact period of stay when fixed.
2. Please send the necessary documentation to the embassy by the deadline determined by each embassy.
3. Applicants who fail to meet the standards indicated under Article 2 of the Outline of Overseas Technical Trainee Acceptance Program of Chiba Prefecture, will not be accepted. Japanese lessons will no longer be provided to applicants. Individuals therefore must have a sufficient proficiency of Japanese or English language ability in order to apply for the program.
4. As this program is a technical training program, candidates interested in studying general areas such as Japanese society or its economic systems, will not be accepted.
Example of technical fields studied by past participants: dental technique, pharmacology, clinical psychology, trade system, interior decoration, car maintenance, environmental research
5. Candidates who apply to study a field of training unrelated to their current occupation will not be accepted.
6. This program is catered towards vocational training, to enhance the ability of participants in their field of technical work upon returning to their home country. Academic researchers and scholars will therefore not be accepted as candidates for this program.
7. Trainees should have appropriate skills to be able to live responsibly and independently, as they will be living alone at commencement of the training.
9. Applicants should have good communication and social skills, and have an interest in interacting with Japanese people.
