The Awards are open in the following two categories:

AIBD TV Award for the Best TV programme on:

Towards a Waste-free Society:

Waste in society can occur in many different forms. There can be household energy wastage, food waste, industrial waste and also issues with waste disposal. What are some of the examples of creative and responsible initiatives to reduce waste in society for a more sustainable future?

Bridging the Gender Gap:

Gender Equality' was listed as No.5 on the United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals. What practical steps have been taken on the ground to achieve this worthy goal towards a gender inclusive society? How can the participation and contribution of women in different arenas of life, from sports to the workplace, be better recognised?

AIBD Radio Award and Reinhard Keune Memorial Radio Award for the Best Radio Programme on:

The Journey of the Migrant:

In recent times, migration has become an issue of global concern. Migrants though are often just described in terms of cold statistics rather than given a human face. Many migrants face untold obstacles and hardships in their search for better prospects or to escape persecution. What personal stories can best highlight the joys and struggles migrants face?

Fighting Deforestation:

Forests cover roughly 30 percent of the world land area and are a vital resource for our survival. Yet every year, vast areas forests are cleared due to logging and agriculture, putting the survival of Earth's ecosystem at risk. Deforestation is one of the most overlooked global crises with tremendously damaging impact to the environment and humanity in general. How can this growing problem be effectively tackled?

We are pleased to present this opportunity to all AIBD members and affiliates. Supported by AIBD, these Awards will provide the opportunity for your television and radio producers to receive international recognition for their work.

"The Prize" consists of US\$500.00 cash, a trophy and a certificate presented by AIBD per Award topic.

Winners and runners-up will be announced during the 43nd Annual Gathering / 16th AIBD General Conference & Associated Meetings, to be hosted by Public Service Media, Maldives in K. Bandos, Maldives from 21 to 23 August 2017.

Please note that producers can submit one programmeper topic (limit of four submissions for the four topics) and the deadline for programme submission is <u>1 July 2017</u>. 3) AIBD Radio Award on "The Best Radio Programme on The Journey of the Migrant"

4) Reinhard Kuene's Radio Award on "The Best Radio Programme on Fighting Deforestation"

A maximum of 90 minutes.

All the entries will be judged according to the following criteria:

- 1. Are the production, sound recording, editing, and mixing quality coordinated so as to enhance the programme?
- Is the subject relevant? How effective is the programme? Is it properly targeted? Is it instructive, creative, entertaining and/or innovative? Does it capture and hold attention?
- The programme must have been aired or must be scheduled for broadcasting in its originating country.
- The programme must have been produced in the last 12 months before submission.
- The programme must be either in English or in any other language with English subtitles. For radio programmes in another language, please provide an English transcript.

Who can submit an entry? ⇒ AIBD members.

How many entries can be submitted? ⇒ Each producer/organisation can submit up to one entry per topic.

Format requested:

⇒ Programmes must be submitted in <u>DVD format</u>.

⇒ 2 DVDs are requested for <u>each</u> programme submitted.
